Learning

We will also look at multiplication calculations and different strategies to solve them.

Science this term is based on Living Things and Habitats where we will be identify living and non-living things and looking at animals and their habitats.



Our topic this term is Winter, we will be looking at different events that happen at this time of year including The Gunpowder Plot and Remembrance Day, along with looking at how the world around us changes at winter time.
